TITLE	Grating Removal (Barricade)
GENERAL	Protecting workers from injuries associated with removal of grating floors or sections of floors
APPLICATION	Removal of partial or whole grating floors is an integral part of maintenance of equipment
PROTECTIVE MECHANISMS	Permit system PPE Barricades (see photo) Safe work procedure ERP (Emergency Response Plan)
SELECTION AND USE	As per safe work procedure
SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY	To facilitate and/or provide proper instruction to their workers on protection requirements and training Hazard assessment Worksite inspection
WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	1. Ensure you are conversant with safe work procedures 2. Install barricades IMMEDIATELY after any removal of grating 3. Ribbon off hazardous area

With the channel iron cut in the method shown in the picture it can be slipped into the grating and locks solidly in place. The chain slips onto hooks to allow for various distance between posts.
